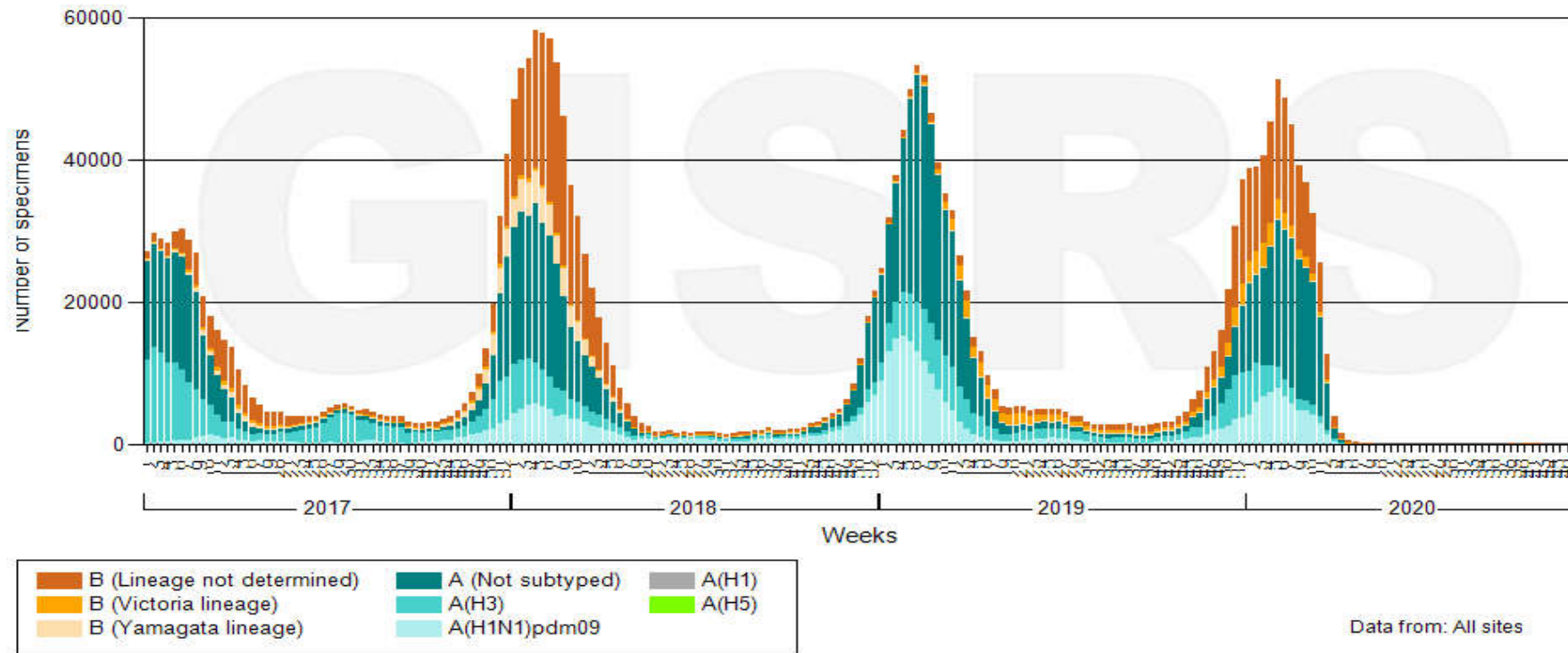

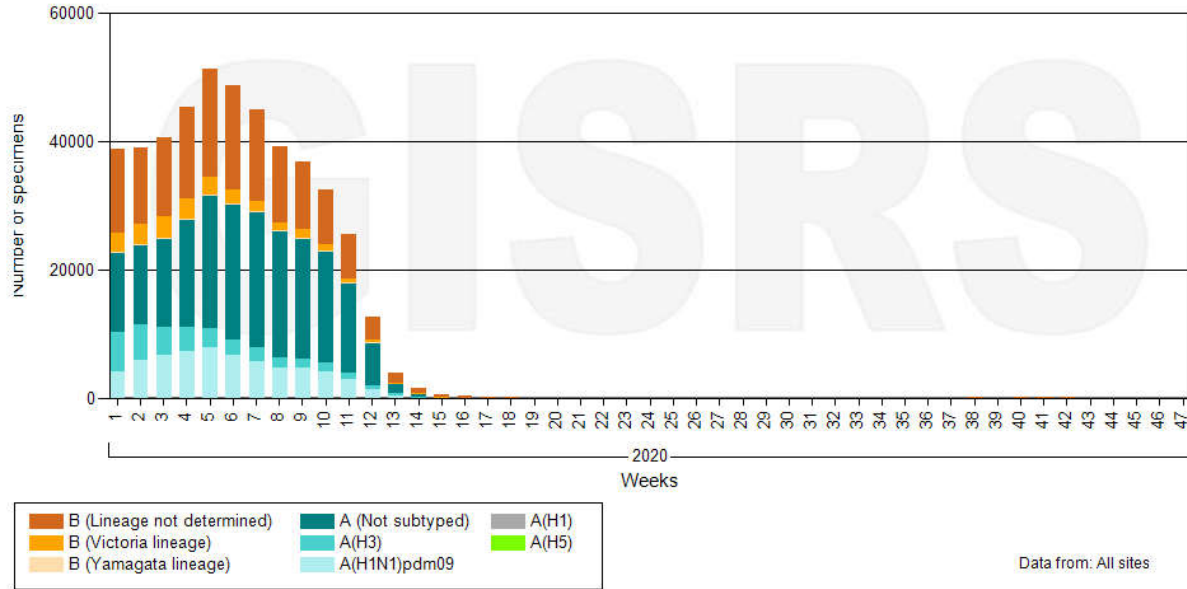

Number of specimens positive for influenza by subtype



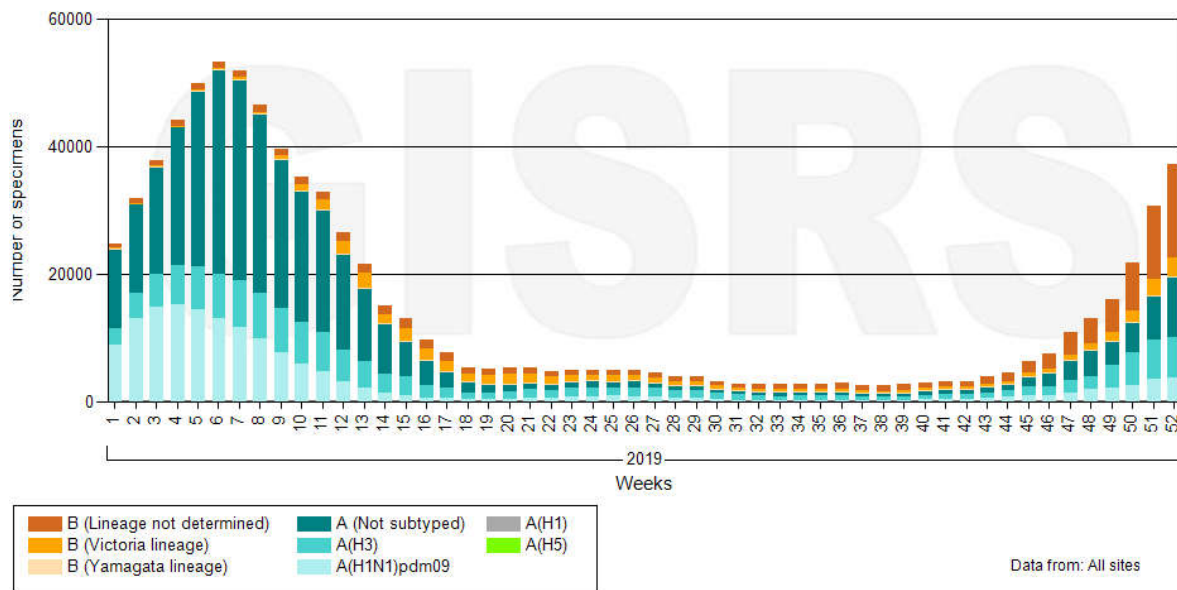

Number of specimens positive for influenza by subtype



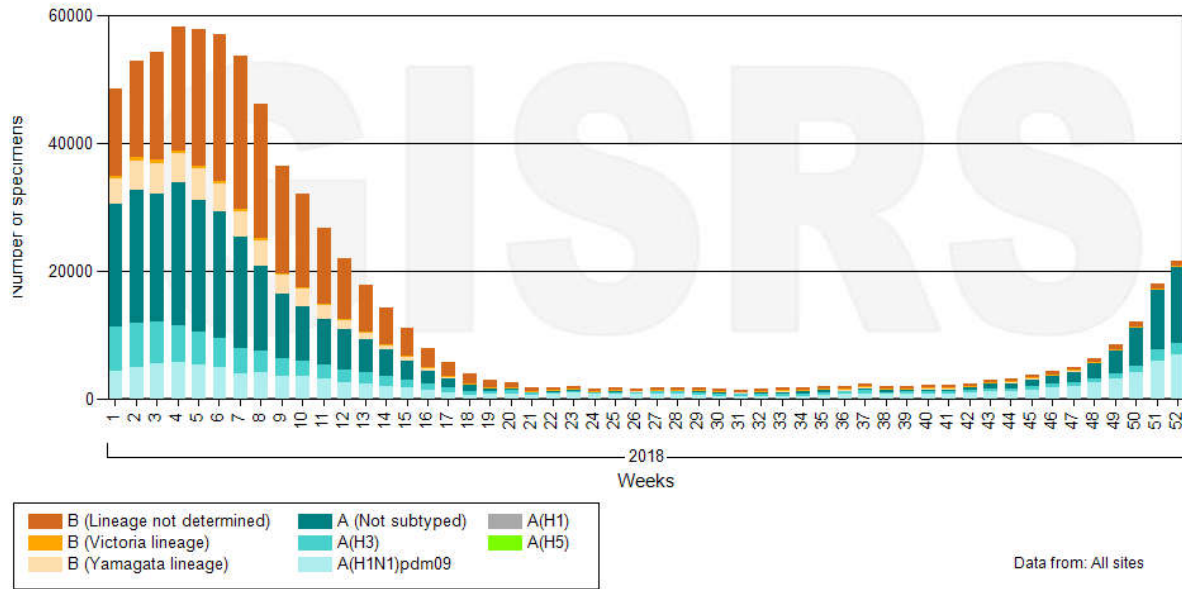

Number of specimens positive for influenza by subtype



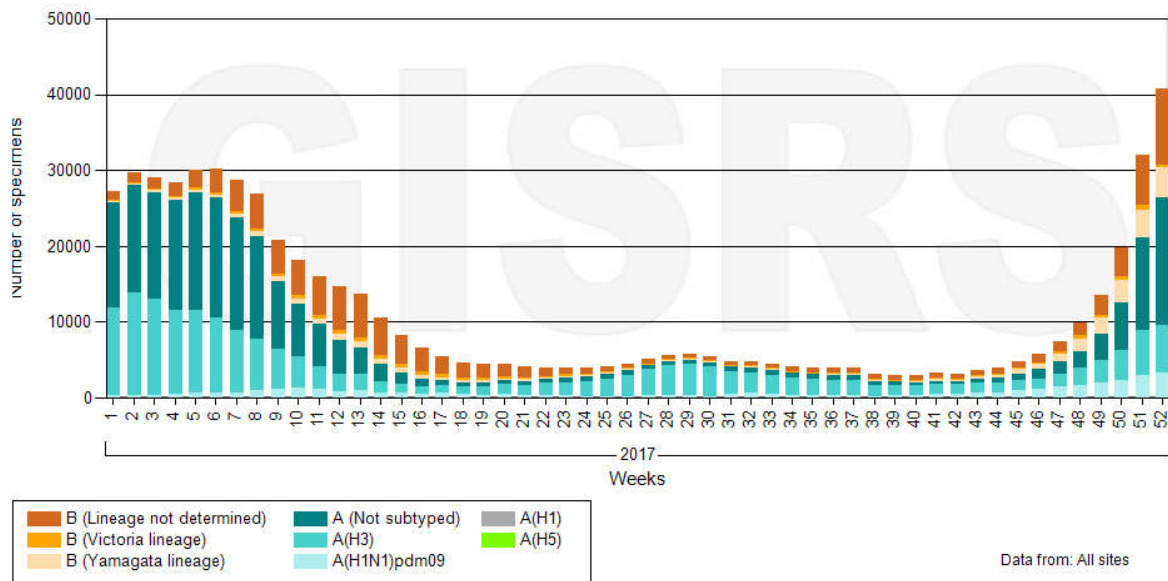
